VOLUNTEER ITEMS: All volunteers receive event t-shirts, snacks, refreshments,



RECOMMEND PARKING:

- Underground parking structure at Crystal City Shops
 - o 2345 Crystal Dr, Arlington, VA 22202
 - o Traffic at South Clark Street is diverted to 26th ST S for access to Crystal Dr and 23rd St Parking Structure.
 - Alternative Route #2: From RTE 1 S, exit at 27th St S, take Crystal Dr. north to parking structure.
 - o Alternative Route #3: Access to Crystal Drive North is also convenient via Airport Access Road from Regan National Airport.
 - o Parking structure is open 24 hours a day


